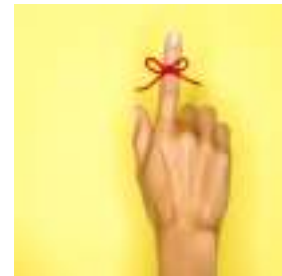

2013 BUDGET

Finalized the Budgets and Budget Narrative. Uploaded to the Borough Web Site for public review and comment. A copy of the Budget Narrative was sent to Council under a separate cover for review. The 2013 Budget is scheduled for Adoption during the December 11, 2012 Regular Council Meeting.

RFP – Auditing Services

The deadline for the proposals was November 29, 2012 at 10:00 AM. The Borough received five (5) proposals with costs for a three (3) contract ranging from \$44,153.00 to \$51,000.00. Current Borough Auditor, Hosack Specht came in at \$16,500/year or \$49,950 for the three (3) years.

Based on the above information and the fact that all proposals came in at around the same costs, we recommend the Borough retain Hosack Specht as the Borough Auditor for another three (3) years. If it is the Borough's intention of switching Auditors every so many years as a good business practice, this could be addressed in three (3) years and if decided this is the reasoning, then Hosack Specht would not be permitted to bid. However, since the main intent this time was to confirm costs of doing the Borough Audit, we do not believe the Borough should switch auditing firms from a firm that has always performed a good job for the Borough and understands the Borough's finances, projects, and system. This will be discussed during the meeting on December 11, 2012.

One NOTE: Cottrill Arbutina's proposal was emailed well in advance of the submittal deadline, however the Borough did not receive their hard copy until Friday, November 30, 2012. It was clearly stated in the RFP that BOTH hard copies and electronic copies shall be in the hands of the Borough not later than 10:00 AM, November 29, 2012.

If interviews are required, they will be scheduled for the week of December 3, 2012 with Council awarding the Contract during the December 11, 2012 Council meeting. Thus far, I have received requests for the RFP from four (4) firms.

ALCOSAN – Consent Decree/Sanitary Sewers Related

3 Rivers Wet Weather

December 2012 Update:

Preparation of your Feasibility Study, due in July 2013, should be well underway. Below is an overview of the major components that will need to be included in your plan. These elements were developed by the 3 Rivers Wet Weather Feasibility Study Working Group collaborating to ensure compliance with the municipal consent order requirements. Items such as cost sharing agreements and development of a Memorandum of Understanding (Suggested guidelines are attached.) for the report will require significant coordination, so be sure to build ample time into the schedule. A model Feasibility Study is being prepared that can be used as a guide.

Note that if your municipality is part of one or more complex sewersheds, you will need to have completed your alternative analysis and selected the most cost-effective approach to compliance. The following items should be considered as you develop the plan;

- a. Identify proposed physical project(s) and cost, and determine if the selected alternative will be constructed as multi-municipal infrastructure.
- b. Determine level of control to be proposed; i.e. design storm for SSO controls, number of overflows in CSO systems.

- c. Consider source reduction and green infrastructure options (Incorporate into leading alternative or list in Feasibility Study appendix to be considered where cost-effective and appropriate.)
- d. Determine cost sharing allocations.
- e. Determine individual municipal cost for sewer O&M and capital projects in all sewersheds.
- f. Determine individual municipal affordability (% of MHI). Be sure to include both ALCOSAN and municipal cost projections in this analysis.
- g. Coordinate individual municipal financial capabilities with other municipalities in shared sewersheds.
- h. Develop implementation schedules for individual municipalities and shared sewersheds that coordinate with the ALCOSAN Consent Decree and Wet Weather Plan.
- i. Initiate development of MOUs or Agreements to cover project implementation.
- j. Consider management and institutional options such as consolidation and regional authorities.
- k. Public meetings on proposed plan are not required by the consent orders, but are recommended.
- l. Develop both individual municipal and shared sewer Feasibility Study approaches and recommendations.
- m. Complete individual Feasibility Study for each municipality addressing each point of connection (POC).
- n. Complete MOUs or Agreements for all multi-municipal sewers and facilities.
- o. Each municipal Council must approve and adopt the individual municipal Feasibility Study prior to the July submittal to DEP or ACHD.

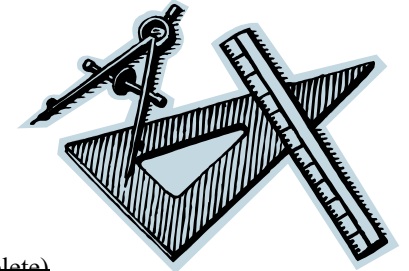

A work authorization to do preliminary work for the paving program was approved by Council. A Kick-Off meeting has been scheduled for Tuesday, December 18th at 9:00 AM with Gateway Engineers.

C-40113-2012 Stormwater Phase II Compliance 01.408.313

Gateway submitted to DEP the NOI (Notice of Intent) permit application for the 2013-2018 permit on September 14, 2012. Along with the NOI Gateway submitted a narrative explaining the strategy for reducing the amounts of phosphates, nitrates, and sediment being discharged into Saw Mill Run which DEP has identified as an approved TMDL (Total Mass Daily Load) waterway.

DEP had returned the NOI packet to Brentwood with comments. Gateway addressed the comments and re-submit the packet to DEP. The Borough has received a letter from the DEP indicating that the resubmitted packet is administratively complete. Through conversations with DEP, it is our understanding that DEP is crediting Gateway and the Borough with submitting the NOI packet on time.
